RULES OF THE GAME

1. **Rules.** All play will be governed by the current USCA Rules of Play.
2. **Qualification.** All participants must be a full-time student in Wisconsin. He/she must attend the same school or live within the same school district boundaries. Loyalty to schools is required. Any student reaching his/her 19th birthday prior to the current school year is ineligible.

Only one girls team and one boys team can represent a school. A curling club from the same town can enter a one girls team and one boys team as long as the players are from the same high school or live within the same school district boundaries.
3. **Supervision.** Teams must be under the direct supervision of a school coach, club junior coordinator, or parent at all times.
4. **Teams.** At the start of a competition, every team shall be composed of four players. It is recommended a team have an alternate, as substitution is permitted between games. In case of an injury, substitution can be done immediately.
5. **Substitution.** The rotation of play established in the first end shall be observed throughout the game. If a player is unable to continue to play, the team may finish the current game and play any subsequent games with three players. If a substitute takes the player's place, rotation of players may be revised and shall continue for the remainder of that game.
6. **Game.** Team should be ready to play at the set draw times. Penalty: 10 minutes late = 1 point, 20 minutes late = 2 points, etc., with a 60-minute forfeiture will apply. No penalty for health or travel problem if it is the first game of the championship.

All games will be 8 ends. Prior to the game, Thirds shall flip a coin to determine which team receives hammer for the first end. Stone color will be pre-determined by site coordinator. Ties will be broken by a full extra end. Each team will be given two time outs during the game taken only between ends. The first time out must be used prior to the start of the fifth end. In the event of an extra end, both teams will have a time out.
7. **Measure.** All measurements for scoring will be done by each team's Third. If the Thirds cannot make a determination, a championship co-chair or a neutral coach will assist in the measurement.

8. **Format.** Championship will be played in a peer-seeded pooled round robin format. Separate pools will be created for boys and girls using "peer seeding" of fellow boys or girls coaches. There will be a minimum of four teams in each pool.

Top team from each pool advances to the semi finals. If there is a first-place tie in a pool, the tie will be broken by head to head game results and then by shoot out score.

When there are three pools, the fourth semi finalist will be determined by the best shoot-out score among the teams with one loss that didn't win their respective pool. Inside the respective pool, the shoot-out score is only used to break three-way ties. Ties between two teams are broken by their head-to-head result. The shoot-out for the affected teams will take place immediately following their last round robin game.

The shoot out will be conducted as follows: Winner of the game (if applicable) may choose to go first or second. Each player will throw one rock in same order as the prior game. A player is allowed to throw one practice stone but must declare it as a practice stone to the official prior to throwing the stone. Scoring is the total inches of the four shots. Shots not touching the house will score 72 inches. Teams may sweep and hold broom.

Semi final pairings will be determined by the highest remaining seed playing the lowest remaining seed that was not in their pool regardless of which of the four teams was the "wild card". #1 ranked team will play #4 ranked team, and #2 ranked team will play #3 ranked team.

9. **Etiquette.** Following each draw, teams will be asked to sit together at the same table in the clubroom to socialize. It is an important aspect and tradition of curling. Team meetings may be held immediately following the game and before socializing.
10. **School Rules.** There will be no smoking on the ice or in the lobby by either participants or coaches. This is a school sport and normal rules of conduct for participants will be observed. Obvious disruptions of the game, foul language, rule breaking, and other discourtesies will not be tolerated. Infractions will result in the guilty team forfeiting the game in progress. This is a game of etiquette. Please conduct yourself accordingly.

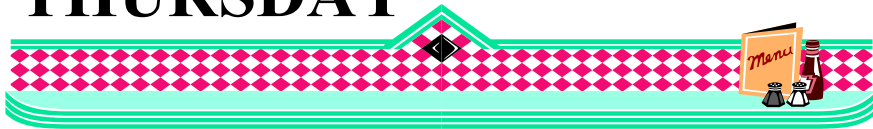

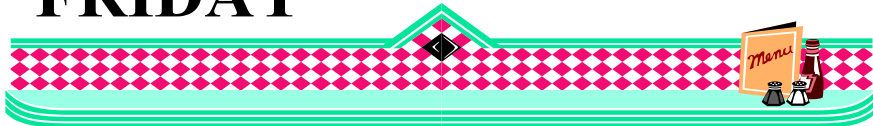
