WCF Report: (Mark Swandby) Changes – cleaned up wording in the rule book, Mixed Doubles changes were made regarding the pre-positioned stones and a person does not have to be at the back at the house holding the broom...can be a sweeper. Power play rule - once during the game...complicated involves a corner guard and a stone buried behind it. LSD changed how to measure rock over the pin.
